


MCL, does not have third party certification for their oxygen specification which validates it as liquid medical oxygen, nor their technical or brochures explain the specification of liquid medical oxygen. Not medical according to any pharmacopeia</p> <p>M/S MCL, does not have the required computerized data surveillance and monitoring system for automated scheduling. There is No central monitoring center to fulfill the requirement.</p> <p>Digital content meter to be installed at each VIE tanks site to co relate it with analog.</p> <p>M/S MCL, has no HTM certified engineer/authorized person available.</p> <p>M/S MCL, does not provide certificate for conformity with international standard of quality (original or attested certification). Specification of tender has required, liquid medical oxygen.</p>	<p>The committee securitized the record & discussed the matter in details. after rechecking of documentation, the committee rejected the firm presentation pladed against M/S Multan Chemical, Multan and upheld the decision of technical advisory committee.</p>

02	M/S Multan Chemical Limited, Multan	Item No. 01 (Liquid Oxygen Gas)	Responsive	<p>Plended against M/S Pakistan Oxygen Gas, Lahore & M/S Ghani Chemical, Lahore</p> <p>M/S POL & M.S Ghani Gases, claim that the third party HTM certification of technical staff for "installation of Hardware at customer site" is false and that company does not exist anywhere,</p> <p>M/S POL does not have own vehicles for the supply of medical gases.</p> <p>M/S POL & M.S Ghani Gases, unable to maintain the 24 hours oxygen backup because they have only main storage which is about 400 KM from the hospital.</p> <p>M/S POL & M.S Ghani Gases, were unable to maintain the said supply as according to demand during 2nd spell of COVID-19.</p> <p>M/S POL & M.S Ghani Gases, charge additional cost, if the consumption of liquid Oxygen increases during any emergency situation .</p> <p>M/S POL & M.S Ghani Gases, does not have reliable telemetry system for monitoring of liquid oxygen contents in tank.</p> <p>M/S POL & M.S Ghani Gases, does not have proper mechanism to check the impurities during pre and post tanker filling of liquid medical oxygen</p>	<p>The committee securitized the record the matter in details. after rechecking on documentation, the committee rejected the presentation pleaded against M/S Pakistan Oxygen Gas & M/S Ghani Chemical, and upheld the decision of technical advisory committee.</p>

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




